Parking

Parking is not allowed on anything on your property other than concrete (not on the dirt or gravel)

Property Appearance

Property visible from the street must be clear of weeds and clutter

Waste bins must be behind cover (not readily visible from the street)

Unapproved Improvements

Any structural improvement including painting, roofing, or major landscaping must be approved by the Architectural Director (and the board)

Non-Payment of Association Fees

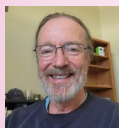
It will result in a non-negotiable late fee

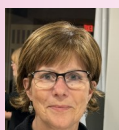
