FROM THE PRESIDENT

Let us start off with good news. The board voted to employ a person, on a part-time basis, to be our Facility Manager. We have hired Adam Smith for that paid position. Mr. Smith has years of experience in managing facilities in the business world.

In his position he will only answer to the board. If you have any suggestions for the facilities or complaints, please present them to the board, not to Mr. Smith.

We are noticing some owners are having their adult children living with them under the guise as caregivers for the parent(s) or the parent is the caregiver for the adult child, yet we see either one of them coming and going separately. Everyone who claims the need for a caregiver or being a caregiver for a senior or underage child/children must provide documentation for proof of the need.

Reminder, all renters as well as new owners **must attend orientation** prior to obtaining a fob for access to the GKA Recreation Area. Also, if the owner who is renting out their property is behind in their dues or fines have been lodged against them, the renter cannot obtain the fob until the owner has taken care of their financial responsibilities. Renters, please do not come to the office to complain

regarding not getting access to the facilities, talk to your landlord. Landlords, please do not contact the GKA office demanding things for your renters, you do not run the Association, take care of your own responsibilities.

Also, renters cannot access the Recreation Area without a fob. If you do access the Recreation Area without a fob, your landlord will be contacted regarding your violations of the rules and may face fines. Renters may be banned from the GKA facilities for rules violations as well as being fined.

To absentee owners/landlords, it is your responsibility to provide tenant information—names, ages and copy of renter's identification, prior to your tenants occupying your property, or face fines. Also, all landlords are responsible for providing their tenants copies of CC&R's, ACC Guidelines, Fines and Violations Guidelines, and GKA Bylaws.

As I wrote in the newsletter recently, the pool hours for children are from 10am to 1pm and the **temporary hours of 5pm to 7pm**. Again, we are seeing individuals in the pool with children after 1pm, and I am tired of the complaints regarding the children's pool hours violations, and summer is not here. Please follow the rules. Remember this is a 55+ community and children's hours are only a gift. The Association is not required to allow children in the pool. If you cannot follow these simple rules, find a civic pool or a private residence with a pool to take the grandchildren to. Please do not request additional hours for children, as I have already received, the answer is no.

Please note, GKA is not in the business of issuing fines nor are we a profit-making entity. Fining is the last resort to get individuals to follow our rules and regulations. 🏌️

As a senior community we are required to maintain 55-plus age status and documentation as such. I've received several new underage persons reports this year which have raised questions from residents. I will try to address this as follows:

Certain non-55 occupants are allowed if they are caregivers or disabled persons. A letter from a caregiver or healthcare provider confirming disability is required.

Extreme emergency circumstances allow for accommodating an underage person for a limited time. The board is not heartless, but we need documentation to keep our 55-plus status. If you have not returned the 2026 survey and appropriate documentation, please do so.

If you have questions you can visit the office on Fridays from 9 am to 12 noon, drop off documentation in the office drop box or outside mailbox, email us, or call me.

Thank you for your cooperation. 🚩

Here it is, that time of year again when we focus on our streets. This year the majority of our streets will be seal coated, which means you won't be able to drive on them **for two days**. Now don't worry, we are breaking this up into 3 sections, and have it set up so there is always an easy exit out of Golf Knolls. Just follow the detour signs and be respectful of others.

Okay, let's get down to it. On **Tuesday, June 9th**, Advanced Paving will be laying a seal coat on **Via Taffia, from Via Zapata to Camino Alba**. This includes **Calle Arrebol**.

On **Wednesday, June 10th**, they will come in and paint the stop lines and speed limits on these streets. Please plan on staying home those two days or avoid that area all together.

The following week on **Tuesday, June 16th**, it will be **Calle Alta, Via Vela, Via Ventoso, Camino Cinife and Via Taffia, from Camino Alba to Via El Brazo**.

On **Wednesday, June 17th**, they will paint the stop lines and speed limits on these streets.

Finally, on **Tuesday, June 23rd**, they will be seal coating on **Via Taffia, from Via El Brazo to the end of the street by lot #1**. Also included will be **Calle Cervato and Calle Cisne**.

Again, on **June 24th**, they will come in and paint the stop lines and speed limits on these streets.

PLEASE PLAN ON AVOIDING THE AREAS THAT ARE SCHEDULED TO BE WORKED ON.

THE ROADS NEED 24 HOURS AFTER APPLICATION TO COMPLETELY SEAL OR ELSE THEY HAVE TO DO IT ALL OVER AGAIN, WHICH MEANS MORE OF AN INCONVENIENCE IN YOUR LIFE.

Flyers will be arriving in your tubes about a week before the days of closures to remind you. Please **DO NOT** park on the street on those days. And as usual, if you want up-to-the-minute updates you can always go to **www.gkahomes.com** and click on "**STREETS**" on the menu.

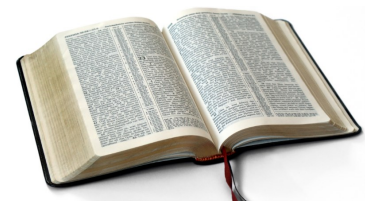
