## Garbage can (brown/black)

- Polystyrene foam containers, treated wood, <u>shredded paper</u>, plastic toys, plastic bags, rags, cloth, rubber
- No:
  - Batteries, Electronics, Fluorescent light bulbs
  - Paint and paint cans, Used motor oil and filters
  - Prescription medications

# Recycle Can (blue/grey):

• Clean glass, aluminum cans, plastic bottles,

### paper, cardboard, steel/aluminum food cans

- aluminum beverage cans, pet food cans, empty aerosol cans, aluminum foil, aluminum cookware can be recycled, and Pizza boxes
- No:
  - Liquids, plastic bags (even if they are called biodegradable), food
  - o plastic toys, lawn furniture, or kiddy pools
  - Polystyrene foam
  - o Shredded paper, auto parts, electronics, batteries

# Organic Can (green)

- Lawn cuttings, food scraps, food may be wrapped in brown paper or newspaper
- No:
  - Plastic bags (even if they are called biodegradable), treated wood, metal, Glass, or cardboard,
