# 2026 Spring Knolls Election News

The 2026 election process is underway. If you haven't received the first election letter explaining the process, you will shortly. Most of this information ran in last month's edition, but it bears repeating.

The Election Rules updates have been approved, and they allow election by acclamation.

Acclamation refers to an uncontested election, in which the number of candidates is equal to or less than the number of vacant seats.

Also, the acclamation process is far less costly because it removes the need for mailing notifications and ballots to every member or the need to pay an Inspector of Elections to count and validate ballots.

All that being said, the Board is hopeful that volunteers will come forward to run for open positions. Current Board members have been serving consecutive terms. Please know that we're not going to serve forever. The camaraderie is great, the pay not so much (a joke).

New members often bring different viewpoints and perspectives. I believe a great board works together to reach overall goals and independently to contribute to the whole.
