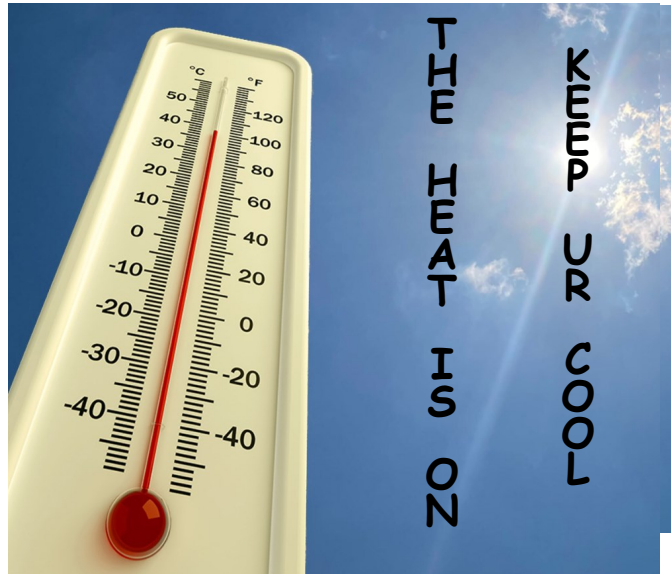

FROM THE PRESIDENT

At the July meeting, there were topics addressed by two individuals who spoke their allotted 3 minutes. Since the topics were done in an open setting, I will share with you what the topics were.

One topic had to do with our hiring a paid individual to be our facilities manager. Another question was posed by this former facility manager asking why he was not appointed to the position on the board after talking with me about the position.

The answers are quite simple, 1) the board wanted someone that has a background in managing facilities, which Mr. Smith has approximately 30 years of experience and training. 2) Why did we not appoint the prior director back to the board? Because he did not submit his name for consideration. In my conversation with him, at the time we had no facility manager, he said if the board needed help with the facilities he would help if needed.

This individual also brought up the fact that the pool heat was turned down to 81F when it was always at 86F. This happened when we had a heater problem along with clogged

filters and reducing the temperature caused less strain on the equipment. He also said what the required temperatures the pool and spa are to be to keep bacteria down.

Here is the true temperature guide Riverside County Health Dept. follows for community pools, which ours is considered:

For community pools 78F to 82F for active lap swimming or 82F to 86F for general recreation, seniors and children. Spas 100F to 102F, not to exceed 104F. As it reads, 81F was within the guidelines.

The other individual complained that the board does not respond to questions he poses at the membership meetings when he speaks his three minutes. This is simple. It says in the meeting standards of conduct, and on the request to speak form, "There is no further discussion from the Board or the Membership once the speaker is finished." As I have told this individual a few times, submit inquiries in writing to the board, and we will respond.

Also Lot A was brought up again. If there is any change in the status quo of Lot A, Judy will advise in an open meeting. Remember **Lot A is a no trespassing area**, and no one is allowed to enter. Only the board can give permission to enter.

We get complaints each month, many the board has no business being involved with and many are people being vindictive.

Here is a point to ponder:

Why is it that those that report violations complain the most when they are found in violation of the rules and regulations of GKA? My suggestion to those living in glass houses, the splinter in the eye verses the log in the eye people, check if you are following the rules before complaining and pointing fingers at others. Why and how do these minor violations affect your life? Why do people complain about other homes that are more than three quarters of a mile from that home? 🏌️

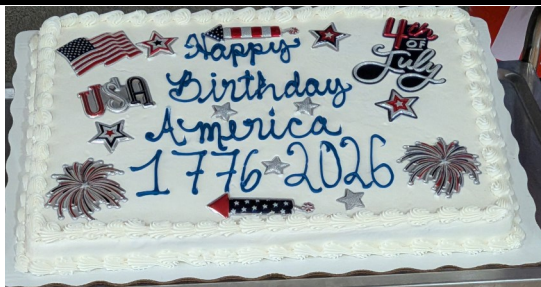

CHANGES TO ERT MEETINGS
EFFECTIVE AUGUST, 2026

Meetings are now held every other month on even-numbered months only. Our next **scheduled meetings** will be **Monday, August 17 (7pm)** and **Wednesday, August 19 (1pm)**.

To reduce confusion, our **meeting times will change** to always be on the **third Monday of every other month (at 1pm)** and the **third Wednesday of every other month (at 7pm)**.

This means that the meetings may now be anywhere up to 9 days apart (not necessarily always in the same week).

ANOTHER IMPORTANT CHANGE: Whether or not we will be having meetings in a given month, radio check-in will still occur **EVERY MONTH** at 6:30pm for **Monday Meetings** and **NOON** for **Wednesday Meetings** (same time every month), using Channel "C." We cannot afford to wait 60 days to find out that a radio isn't working, so your compliance is critical.

Meeting dates and radio check-in will always be noted on the Calendar (back) page of each Newsletter. Please make note of this and mark it on your calendar (Google or hardcopy) and/or set reminders on your cell phone. ➤

It's time to start focusing on the election of Directors for the GKA HOA Board. While it may seem early to start thinking about 2027, the clock is ticking on certain tasks that must be completed well before January 1, 2027. The deadlines are mandated by state law (Davis-Stirling). There is little change from last years process except that wherever permitted the *Golf Knolls News* will be used to communicate official election information. This saves having to print and mail over 500 individual notices (which saves all of us money).

The Nomination procedures must be made available by mail or General Notice (e.g., this Newsletter or the Marquee outside of the Banquet Room) no later than September 15, 2026. This Newsletter will satisfy that requirement.

At printing, there are three openings for which Nominations may be submitted. Nominees will be required to go through a vetting process. If the number of vetted Nominees is equal to or less than the number of openings, no election will be necessary (no voting required) as Nominees will be seated on the Board through acclamation.

To be eligible to serve on the Board, candidates must meet these qualifications:

- GKA Homeowner for at least one year prior to taking office
- Current on payment of outstanding or delinquent HOA dues, liens and/or assessments
- Joint owners may not serve concurrent terms, although Nominations will be accepted if the incumbent member and Nominee terms will not overlap
- Nominations must be submitted to the GKA Office on an Official Candidate Nomination Form so that is received in the GKA Office on or before 5:00pm on the nomination deadline of October 15, 2026. That form is inside this Newsletter on Page 11 (the facing page) and will also be available from the HOA Office.
- Self-Nomination is permitted
- Only one ballot is allowed for each lot owner, regardless of number of residents. Duplicate ballots or votes for write-in candidates will not be counted.

Ballots will be distributed in early December, 2026 (no earlier than December 4, 2026 and no later than December 9, 2026). Ballots must be received in the GKA Office on or before 5:00pm on the voting deadline of January 8, 2027. Late ballots will be not be opened or counted.

Votes will be tallied and the new Board will be installed at the Annual Meeting, scheduled for January 11, 2027.

CANDIDATE NOMINATION FORM FOR 2027 BOARD OF DIRECTORS

There are currently four open positions to fill on the 2027 GKA Board of Directors. The elected Directors will be sworn in at the Golf Knolls **annual open meeting** to be held on **Monday, January 11, 2027, at 6:00 pm** in the **Banquet Room** located at **29070 Camino Alba, Murrieta, CA 92563**. The new Directors will serve a two (2) year term. If the number of Nominees is equal to or fewer than the open positions, the open seats may be filled by acclamation without a formal vote (Davis-Stirling Act, Civil Code 5103).

If you are an Owner who is interested in serving on the Board or wishes to nominate someone else, please complete the form below and ensure it is received in the GKA office before the deadline. Before nominating someone else, please ensure they are willing to serve before submitting the form. No nominations will be accepted if received after the **deadline of 5:00pm on Thursday, October 15, 2026**.

Joint Owners may not serve on the Board concurrently, although Nominations will be accepted if the incumbent member and Nominee terms will not cause a conflict. No more than one vote per owner. We also ask **all Nominees to submit a candidate statement** briefly describing their qualifications, reasons for running, and any other pertinent information. All candidate statements are limited to a few paragraphs on a single page, typed in a 12-point font or clearly printed by hand. Neither the Inspector of Elections nor any Board Director may edit or redact your statement, but they may include an additional statement specifying that the candidate, and not the Association, is responsible for the content.

All nomination forms must be received by the INSPECTOR OF ELECTIONS on or before 5:00 pm on Thursday, October 15, 2026.
